Formula
Circumference $=\pi d$


Find the circumference to 1 dp


Radius $=5$, Diameter $=10$
Circumference $=\pi \times d$
Circumference $=\pi \times 10$
Circumference $=31.4 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Key Words

Perimeter: The
distance around the outside of the shape. Unit of measure: This could be any unit of length cm , inch, m , foot, etc.
Dimensions: The lengths which give the size of the shape. Circumference: The perimeter of a full circle.
